Following the celebration, we received this letter from a visitor

On hearing of St. Mary's inspirational plan for celebrating Pentecost this year, I travelled from Warwickshire to take part.

As I waited in the pew for the ceremony to begin, I noticed the words 'Que la paix soit avec vous' written on the pillar beside me. This blessing was repeated on all the other pillars in many other languages. I was ready to be impressed!

The Mass began with a huge procession of children, adults, flags and banners, borne on a wave of vitality and exuberance which held throughout the ceremony. The children, all with headbands marked with Tongues of Fire, were involved in every aspect of the Pentecostal celebration and recited Bidding Prayers in their own languages with confidence and aplomb.

As intended, it was all so wonderfully illustrative of Pentecost, when God revealed himself as the God of every nation, culture and tongue.

Although unknown to the parish, I felt welcomed and at home when I joined the celebrations in the hall afterwards. I had the impression of a very warm and happy parish with a youthful tone and outlook.

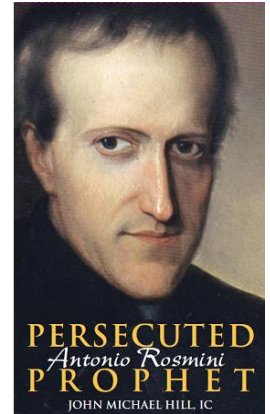

A new biography of Antonio Rosmini,

the first in English for over half a century, will be published in July.

Fr Michael Hill places Rosmini in the context of his family, his friends, his foes and his nation. He evaluates the impact Rosmini had on other significant figures in the Church, and on his followers in the Institute of Charity and the Sisters of Providence.



What emerges is something of a tragic story. Though greatly loved and admired by many, he was also often misunderstood, bitter attacks on him by his enemies within the Church and in international politics were the source of much anguish for him. Rosmini has finally been rehabilitated by the Church and his holiness recognised. A persecuted prophet and an important figure in the intellectual development of the Church, he is very much a prophet for our time.
