**Point to Ponder:** Sometimes it's hard not to fear: for example, if you get a bad diagnosis from the doctor, lose a job, or hear a piece of terrible news. That's when comfort can be found in the old adage about real religion and false religion: **false religion** says that if you believe in God, nothing bad will ever happen, so don't worry. **Real religion** says that even if you believe in God, something bad might happen, but there's no need to worry. In fearful times we tend to forget that God is right there with us, no matter what happens - through our priests, friends, families, even our doctors - and that God gives us all sorts of resources to deal with our problems and move through them. The key is remembering all this when the fear starts and focusing on the trust instead.

A **Second Collection** for the **Apostleship of the Sea** will be held on **12<sup>th</sup> July**: This Catholic charity provides practical and pastoral care to all seafarers, regardless of nationality, belief or race, in more than 250 ports around the world. 90% of world trade is transported by ship; however, the life of a seafarer can be dangerous and lonely, with up to a year at a time away from home, separated from family and loved ones and often working in harsh conditions. This charitable organisation relies wholly on voluntary contributions and is only able to continue its work through the generous donations of supporters and volunteers.
